## KATE'S KOLUMN — AN INTERGROUP VALENTINE

Webster defines “valentine” as “a written or other artistic work, message, token, etc. expressing affection for something or someone.”

Last Friday, the 12-step calls were coming in pretty often. Every woman I spoke to had a bottom similar to mine. One was experiencing terrible anxiety attacks, another had suicidal thoughts, and another didn't want to go to meetings and asked if there was another way to stop drinking besides going to AA. In all cases, I could relate my experience with the program and how I had once felt. It often doesn't matter the words spoken. What matters is the love and affection extended to another alcoholic. The paradox in those calls is that I hung up feeling useful and with a renewed gratitude for my recovery.

During February, the love month, let's try to talk to more beginners who are groping to find their way into recovery. Their thoughts are often that we have something they don't have...that we don't understand what they are going through. Of course, we do. If we can't talk to them, perhaps it is just as loving to simply listen.

Bill W. talked about the disciplines we need for recovery in our 12 & 12 (pg. 174) as follows: “We of A.A. obey spiritual principles, at first because we must, then because we ought to, and ultimately because we love the kind of life such obedience brings. Great suffering and great love are A.A.'s disciplinarians; we need no others.”

My own suffering in active alcoholism helped me with the Friday calls. I had anxiety attacks, I had suicidal thoughts, I didn't believe A.A. could help me at first. So, my own past suffering and the great suffering the callers had experienced enabled me to know what to say and, in turn, they seemed to hear me. In A.A., we don't say “I got mine, now you get yours.” Instead we say “I can help you. Here is what helped me.”

I may or may not get chocolates, a valentine, or flowers on Valentines Day. But, the big valentine for me is the joy of reaching out to others and the realization that all my suffering has been turned into good. My Higher Power has transformed all the pain into healing.

In an article from the March, 1962 Grapevine, Bill W. stated: “One exercise that I practice is to try for a full inventory of my blessings and then for a right acceptance of the many gifts that are mine—both temporal and spiritual. Here I try to achieve a state of joyful gratitude. When such a brand of gratitude is repeatedly affirmed and pondered, it can finally displace the natural tendency to congratulate myself on whatever progress I may have been enabled to make in some areas of living. I try hard to hold fast to the truth that a full and thankful heart cannot entertain great conceits. When brimming with gratitude, one's heartbeat must surely result in outgoing love, the finest emotion that we can ever know.”

### **SECOND STEP: “Came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity.”**

“As material success founded upon no more than these ordinary attributes began to come to us, we felt we were winning at the game of life. This was exhilarating, and it made us happy. Why should we be bothered with theological abstractions and religious duties, or with the state of our souls here or hereafter? The here and now was good enough for us.”

### **SECOND TRADITION: “For our group purpose there is but one ultimate authority—a loving God as He may express Himself in our group conscience. Our leaders are but trusted servants; they do not govern.”**

“So spoke the group conscience. The group was right and I was wrong; the voice on the subway was not the voice of God. Here was the true voice, welling up out of my friends. I listened, and—thank God—I obeyed.”

### **SECOND CONCEPT: “When in 1955, the A.A. groups confirmed the permanent charter for their General Service Conference, they thereby delegated to the Conference complete authority for the active maintenance of our world services and thereby made the Conference—excepting for any change in the Twelve Traditions or in Article 12 of the Conference Charter—the actual voice and the effective conscience for our whole Society.”**

“But the groups' acceptance of ultimate service authority and responsibility was not enough. No matter what authority the groups had, they could not meet their new responsibilities until they had actually delegated most of the active ones. It was precisely in order to meet this need that the General Service Conference of Alcoholics Anonymous was given the general responsibility for the maintenance of A.A.'s world services and so became the service conscience for A.A. as a whole.”
