KATE'S KOLUMN — SILENT NIGHTS AND DAYS

I love to talk. Anyone is always welcome to my opinion. Do you want to talk about the upcoming election, the latest electronic gadget, or the price of eggs in Milwaukee? I'm there. I can walk right up to strangers and strike up a conversation. It's easy for me. When grace brought me into A.A., it was easy for me to "share". (Getting honest is an entirely different subject, however.)

What stumped me was meditation. To be still and quiet was foreign to me. Getting the body settled came easier than the mind. I wanted to get up and do a load of wash or find my pocketbook, but I stayed...for a few seconds anyway while the stillness felt like ants marching over my skin. Then, my mind wouldn't stop. When I tried to just "be", my mind went through my entire life like a motorboat on an ocean.

In a letter he wrote in 1946, Bill W. said "Constructive meditation is the first requirement for each new step in our spiritual growth." I tried listening to my breathing, warm soaks in the tub, candlelit evenings with meditative music softly playing in the background. Then, miracle of miracles, I found myself refreshed and at peace at the end of the meditation time. I fell in love with the practice and decided I was home...at last.

Then someone I love talked to me about another spiritual practice—about not complaining. He explained that it was arrogance and ingratitude to complain about anything, that our very existence was a gift. Whoa! Not complaining about anything? How do you do that? There was so much to complain about—the idiots in traffic, the cost of everything, the crazy world we live in. The first day I tried not to complain I felt like someone had a gag on me. I wanted to explain the depth of my everyday misery to anyone who would listen. Not doing that required great strength. Today I know that my spiritual program is directly proportional to my complaints. There's a saying, "What's the sense of complaining. No one wants to hear it." Absolutely no one gains from my complaints. I don't even feel better afterwards. And, so I practice. There are difficulties...but then what's the sense in complaining?

First Step: "We admitted we were powerless over alcohol, that our lives had become unmanageable."

We know that little good can come to any alcoholic who joins A.A. unless he has first accepted his devastating weakness and all its consequences. Until he so humbles himself, his sobriety—if any—will be precarious. Of real happiness he will find none at all. Proved beyond doubt by an immense experience, this is one of the facts of A.A. life. The principle that we shall find no enduring strength until we first admit complete defeat is the main taproot from which our whole Society has sprung and flowered."

First Tradition: "Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends upon A.A. unity."

"The unity of Alcoholics Anonymous is the most cherished quality our Society has. Our lives, the lives of all to come, depend squarely upon it. We stay whole, or A.A. dies. Without unity, the heart of A.A. would cease to beat, our world arteries would no longer carry the life-giving grace of God; His gift to us would be spent aimlessly. Back again in their caves, alcoholics would reproach us and say, "What a great thing A.A. might have been!"

First Concept: "The final responsibility and the ultimate authority for A.A. world services should always reside in the collective conscience of our whole Fellowship."

The trusteeship was designed to inaugurate and maintain all of those special services for A.A. as a whole that could not well be performed by single groups or areas. We envisioned the writing of a uniform A.A. literature, the development of a sound public relations policy, and a means of handling the large numbers of pleas for help that might follow in the wake of national and international publicity. We thought in terms of aiding new groups to form and of furnishing them with counsel based upon the experience of the older and already successful groups. We thought there would be a need for a monthly magazine and also for translations of our literature into other languages.
