KATE'S KOLUMN— THE PRESENT OF THE MOMENT

In the rooms, we are reminded about living a day at a time. On television talk shows we hear about the peace we find when living a moment at a time. Why? How did we ever live without paring down our lives into days and moments? I remember living in hell thinking about the past and the future. I didn't realize that my mind was back there in all the turmoil or projected there in imagined turmoil. It was my reality.

Getting sober was a slow and painful time in a desert wilderness. Everything looked hopeless because I was remembering the people "who didn't like me", and I projected negatively about dealing with people or problems in the future. When I had some days I began to have experiences that weren't as bad as I projected. And, if I were looking into my past, I came to realize that the people who didn't like me were really people who loved me but were tired of dealing with me. As I worked the inward steps (four through nine) I came to see that I had many blessings I didn't notice. I was too busy to notice because of the fear and worry in my mind.

Sober we are useful. Sober we do not live a sterile existence. Sober we blaze new trails. We clear up the slimy mark left by our poor actions or our lazy inactivity. We slowly learn to mature, to stop making faces and stomping our feet like a child. We no longer say "This is how I am," but say instead "I need to change that and I will." We get used to saying no when we mean no. We don't fly like a turkey when we can soar like an eagle. We learn that our voices have "tones" to them and we try to learn discretion. We don't put our work off until tomorrow if it should be done today. We don't think useless thoughts (which are a waste of time), but we try to think of others and what they might need. There is no place for lukewarm.

We can't come to these "new ideas" if we migrate in the past and the future. The best present I got in sobriety was discovering the present moment. And, right here, right now, all is well.

NINTH STEP: Made direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others.

"As soon as we begin to feel confident in our new way of life and have begun, by our behavior and example, to convince those about us that we are indeed changed for the better, it is usually safe to talk in complete frankness with those who have been seriously affected, even those who may be only a little or not at all aware of what we have done to them. The only exceptions we will make will be cases where our disclosure would cause actual harm."

Page 85, Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions

NINTH TRADITION: A.A., as such, ought never be organized; but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve.

"Just as the aim of each A.A. member is personal sobriety, the aim of our services is to bring sobriety within reach of all who want it. If nobody does the group's chores, if the area's telephone rings unanswered, if we do not reply to our mail, then A.A. as we know it would stop. Our communications lines with those who need our help would be broken."

Page 175, Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions

NINTH CONCEPT: Good service leaders, together with sound and appropriate methods of choosing them, are at all levels indispensable for our future functioning and safety. The primary world service leadership once exercised by the founders of A.A. must necessarily be assumed by the Trustees of the General Service Board of Alcoholics Anonymous.

"No matter how carefully we design our service structure of principles and relationships, no matter how well we apportion authority and responsibility, the operating results of our structure can be not better than the personal performance of those who must man it and make it work."
